Automated/autonomous driving (AD)

- AD requires high-definition maps
- Eventually, the whole navigable/drivable world will be
 - mapped with very high precision, where
 - maps are updated with very high frequency
 - and from different sources
- AD requires international standards for maps and global cooperation between all stakeholders



Working mode and meetings




The OADF members agreed on the following
