










- Published in May 2016
- For experimental driving of vehicles that are driven in automated mode
- Making it clear that no permission/report is required as long as the trial organization follows the Guidelines






Tests of level 3,4 have been conducted on public roads in various parts of Japan.


Criteria for the Permission for Public Road Testing of Automated Driving


- Published in September 2019
- For the permission by the police, essential for the test of automated driving with
 - remote control technology
 - unconventional vehicle with special controlling device (different from steering wheel and accelerator / brake pedal)





(*)intervene only when necessary, such as in emergency





Public road tests of automated driving have been implemented

- •in 5 prefectures (with remote control technology)
- •in 4 prefectures (with unconventional vehicle)
