Name**Object of the Project**

In order for Japan to play an active role as a country in the leading position in international standardization activities, etc. for automated driving systems, it has become an urgent necessity to accelerate research, which requires a research and development environment open to the rest of the world (an internationally open research institute) for establishing basic principles and promoting the international standardization of automated driving systems.

Project Summary

Filed operational test equipment for Driving Safety Support Systems (DSSS), which uses radio waves and which was installed on a test course (at Japan Safe Driving Center, Central Training Academy for Safe Driving) in fiscal 2016, was installed on two public roads (one in Saitama Prefecture and the other in Osaka Prefecture).

Future plan

The utilization of the filed operational test equipment which was installed this time will be promoted.
